Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize a public hearing to gather input on the draft Facility Plan for the Maple Plain 8352 Forcemain Improvements, Project Number 802803.

Background

A public hearing is required for a draft facility plan prior to its adoption by the Metropolitan Council as a condition for obtaining project financing through the Minnesota Public Facilities Authority.

Rationale

Project improvements are required to maintain and improve the regional wastewater conveyance system; maintain system capacity and improve system reliability. The improvements that are planned include:

- Installation of approximately 7,100 L.F. of 16-inch pipe in the west segment
- Installation of approximately 8,400 L.F. of 16-inch pipe in the east segment

Funding

Project 808603 is included in the 8086 family of projects in the 2026 MCES Authorized Capital Program.
