

What is The Parks Equity Tool

- The Parks Equity Tool is an app that supports the equity analysis requirement by comparing demographics and park access, using the American Community Survey (ACS) and Met Council data.
- Additionally, the tool can be used for outreach, programming planning, and research.

Why update the Equity Analysis Tool?

- The former equity tool was using outdated American Community Survey data and code
- Relied on manual updates
- Desire to improve visuals and smoother functionality for all users
- More intuitive and easier to navigate

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Main Changes: Data Updates + Workflow Improvements










- ACS 2023 demographics integrated


Main Changes: Visuals and User Experience

- Added more context and resources to the website


Looking Ahead
