Figure 1 shows the summary of the 177 submitted applications for the Regional Solicitation and Active Transportation Solicitations.

- The Active Transportation Solicitation received 83 applications across three competitive categories. The total grant request for the Active Transportation Solicitation surpassed \$142 million, with approximately \$50 million in regional transportation sales and use tax funds expected to be available for 2027, 2028, and 2029.
- The Regional Solicitation received 92 applications across 10 competitive categories. Requests for the Arterial Bus Rapid Transit J Line and the Regional Modeling/Travel Behavior Inventory were also received after being vetted through other prioritization processes. The total grant request for the Regional Solicitation exceeded \$574 million, with approximately \$215 million in federal funds expected to be available for 2030 and 2031.

The applications have been posted to the [2026 Regional Solicitation Submitted Applications](#) page. Applications will begin scoring and evaluation in July and conclude in the fall. Then, the Transportation Advisory Board will begin developing funding options with input from the Technical Advisory Committee and the public for final selection to occur in early 2027.
