

BOSSEN FIELD AREA SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT

UPDATE: APRIL 13, 2026

Restoration efforts for the Bossen Field project are underway. Beginning Monday, April 27, the remaining temporary conveyance piping will be removed. The contractor will then begin to seed and sod the park, and asphalt will be repaired in impacted areas. Restoration is expected to continue through the end of May.

Upcoming road closures are expected to begin on Monday, April 27, and detour routes will be advertised once confirmed. Please be aware of construction work and crews entering and exiting the area when moving through the area.

CONTINUING ROAD CLOSURES

58th Street East

- Closed from 26th to 28th Avenue South
- Closed from 28th Avenue South to the entrance of the Bossen Field southside parking lot

PROJECT OVERVIEW – PHASE 1

Metropolitan Council plans to remove and replace the aging sanitary sewer pipe in the Bossen Field area of South Minneapolis. This project will be completed in two phases. In Phase 1, an aging pipe will be rehabilitated with CIPP from 58th Street, through Bossen Field Park, and end on 29th Avenue. This phase of the project will include approximately 1,800 feet of CIPP and restoration of seven maintenance holes.
