

BOSSEN FIELD AREA SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT

UPDATE: APRIL 23, 2026

Beginning Monday, April 27, the remaining temporary conveyance piping will be removed and road closures will begin. The contractor will then begin to seed and sod the park, and asphalt will be repaired in impacted areas. Restoration is expected to continue through the end of May.

More information on upcoming road closures is below. Detour routes will remain the same as the closures in December 2025. Please be aware of construction work and crews entering and exiting the area and follow all posted detours.

UPCOMING ROAD CLOSURES

28th Avenue South

- The 58th Street intersection will be closed from **April 27 - May 1**. Access to Highway 62 from southbound 28th Avenue will not be available throughout the closure. Follow posted detours.

56th Street East

- The 29th Avenue intersection will be closed from **May 4 - 8**. Follow posted detours.

CONTINUING ROAD CLOSURES

58th Street East

- Closed from 26th to 28th Avenue South
- Closed from 28th Avenue South to the entrance of the Bossen Field southside parking lot

PROJECT OVERVIEW – PHASE 1

Metropolitan Council plans to remove and replace the aging sanitary sewer pipe in the Bossen Field area of South Minneapolis. This project will be completed in two phases. In Phase 1, an aging pipe will be rehabilitated with CIPP from 58th Street, through Bossen Field Park, and end on 29th Avenue. This phase of the project will include approximately 1,800 feet of CIPP and restoration of seven maintenance holes.

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
