

Metropolitan Wastewater Treatment Plant Primary & Secondary Renewal Project, #808935

Construction Update – August 2026

Metropolitan Council Environmental Services (Met Council) is rehabilitating and renewing Metro aging infrastructure and improving scum handling systems. The scope of this work is happening throughout the Plant and includes: Replacement of 2 influent sluice gates, concrete repairs of the east primaries, south influent channel, and gravity thickeners, reclaiming pavement to renew roads, replacing 8 PLCs, rehabilitating wall tile at CMP, improving the scum system by replacing pumps, installing new piping/valves, and adding an addition to EPT, and rehabilitating HVAC systems at CMP and EPR.

UPCOMING WORK

- CMU Block at the EPT Addition
- Repair work at Primary Tank #4.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Overall duration is 2025 through 2030 as work is completed as seasonal weather conditions dictate.

The wastewater treatment plant remains in full operation during the construction.
