The work of this project includes: Remove and replace approximately 2,050 feet of Interceptor 1-MN-346 and all City of Minneapolis sewer, water, storm utilities, and surface improvements within the limits of disturbance on 29th Avenue S between 53rd and 56th Street East and an existing City of Minneapolis lift station. The work will require piling, excavation dewatering, temporary wastewater conveyance, contaminated soil handling, and work on sewer and water services for 72 homes
